In the spring of 2018, one man began by walking.
Twenty-six days later, the oligarchy fell — without a single death.
In June 2026, the people voted again.
The unfinished revolution received a second mandate.

Ilkka Ronkainen was there for both. He watched the first revolution take shape from twenty meters away — and spent eight years watching what it could not finish.

This book is his answer: what kind of society should Armenia build?

Ronkainen makes a practical case for Armenia as a Dignity Society — a country where every citizen has AI in their own language, where human flourishing is the measure of development, and where village communities are the foundation of national renewal.

The book proposes a value process from villages to the constitution, maps the rights every Armenian should claim, and presents AI Living Lab Baghramjan — a pilot showing how the revolution spreads from one village to an entire nation.

Armenia has transformed itself twice.
The question is what it builds next.

Ilkka Ronkainen is a Finnish-Armenian social scientist, management consultant, and author. He helped build one of the world's most admired public sectors in Finland, moved to Armenia in 2010, received Armenian citizenship after the 2018 revolution, and has witnessed both of the country's bloodless transformations.
